



**Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act • Workforce Office of Western Illinois
Local Workforce Area 14**

The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) is designed to help job seekers access employment, education, training, and support services to succeed in the labor market and to match employers with the skilled workers they need to compete in the global economy.

General Eligibility

Anyone enrolled in WIOA Services must be a citizen of or authorized to work in the United States and registered with selective service if male, over 18 years of age and born after December 29, 1959.

WIOA provides services to individuals who have been laid off and are unemployed through no fault of their own.

Programs and Services

The program is designed to train/retrain dislocated workers and assist in their transition to new employment.

Services include job search assistance including resume development, referral to other appropriate agencies, comprehensive assessments and development of individual employment plans, career planning, and access to Labor Market Information.

Programs include skills training (up to a maximum of two years), On-The-Job Training, support services during training such as mileage to and from school and childcare/elder care.
